Uniforms de JHAE 2023-2024

Just as a reminder of our uniform policy and the schedule. Starting on Monday, August 28th, all students must follow the uniform policy as outlined above. Here is some additional information regarding our uniform dress days and reminder of our uniform policy.

Pants:

- jeans/khaki pants, shorts, or skirts that are blue, black or tan (with no holes.). Shorts and skirts should be no more than 3 inches above the knee. <u>ECE:</u> For students who are in ECE (3 to 4 year old), they are permitted to wear leggings (for the girls) or sweatpants that are blue, black, or brown (without holes.)

Shoes:

Should be closed-toed shoes., with no flashing lights or "heelies" (for student safety and to eliminate distractions).
